Mulgumpin / Moreton Island

Cruise across to Moreton Island, the third largest sand island in the world, to discover this natural wonder. Take in the view from a scenic heli-flight, explore the island on quad bikes, kayak the crystal-clear water, toboggan down the sand dunes, or snorkel the shipwrecks for the ultimate fish-spotting playground. <u>Howard Smith Wharves</u> - Enjoy the best seat in the house right under the Story Bridge on the edge of the sparkling Brisbane River. Spoilt for choice with some of Brisbane's best restaurants and bars; pop champagne at Mr Percival's overwater bar, down craft beers and wood-fired pizza at Felons Brewing Co, or savour Greek tapas at Greca.



Riverlife - Kayak the river, rock climb the Kangaroo Point cliffs, take a yoga class in the outdoor pavilion, or a romantic riverside picnic.



Story Bridge Adventure Climb – Enjoy an elevated adventure with the exhilarating Story Bridge Adventure Climb and dare yourself to Walk the Plank or do a Cantilever Lean Out high above the river.



New Farm Park - See a comedy or theatre show at the Brisbane Powerhouse. Delight in the famous rose gardens or dance the tango in the heritage-listed gazebo.



South Bank - Stroll the pretty flowered arbour, sink your toes into Streets Beach, don't miss live music on Sundays or shipping history at Queensland Maritime Museum.



Eat Street - Graze from over 70 vendors serving global tastes from brightly branded shipping containers, eclectic boutiques, micro restaurants and live music.
